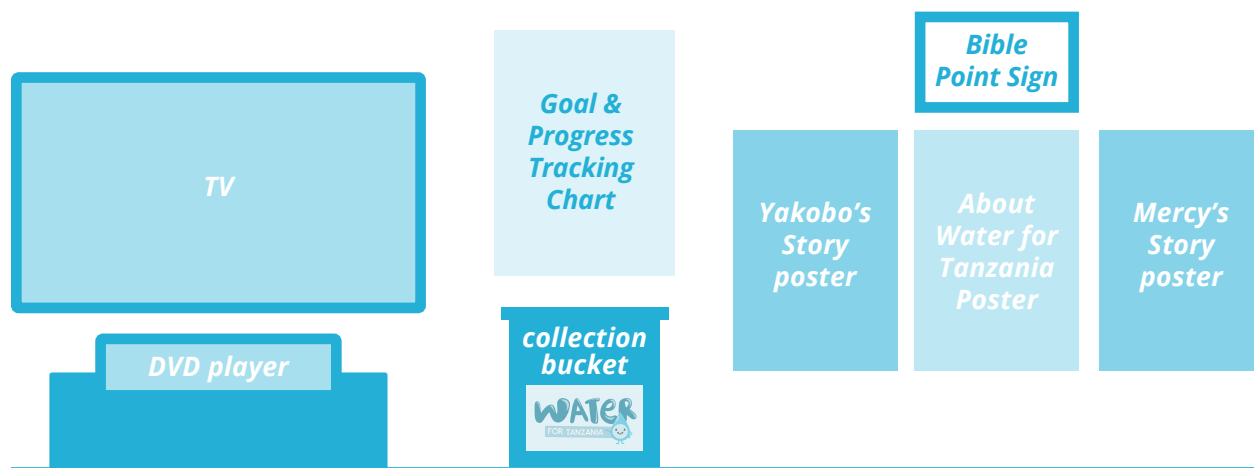


Decorating Tips

As you determine how to set up your missions area, you may want to select one wall as your focal wall to display teaching items in your Water for Tanzania Mission Packet. Keeping the focal wall simple with teaching items will eliminate distractions while teaching biblical truths.

Focal Wall Suggestions

- Place a TV and a DVD player to one side of the focal wall
- Hang "Yakobo's Story" poster, "Mercy's Story" poster and "About Water for Tanzania" poster on the other side of the focal wall
- Using the blank 11x17" signs in your Mission Packet, write each day's Bible Point on its own sign. Then, using an existing Bulletin Board or create an area where you can add your Bible Point Signs each day of your VBS.
- Display your Goal & Progress Tracking Chart on the focal wall. Be sure to update the Progress tracker each day.
- Make sure to pick up a bin or bucket and apply your Water for Tanzania sticker to the front of it. Your bucket should be visible in front of your focal wall every day.

Fun Ideas for the Rest of the Room

- * Place themed backdrop panels on a focal wall
- * Display the appropriate Rotation Sign outside the room
- * Use shades of green and yellow butcher paper to cut blades of grass to put along the walls to represent grassy areas
- * Use tissue paper grass mats to accentuate focal points
- * Cut large water drops out of blue paper to lead the way into the room
